A much improved number of cattle forward with trade still good but not quite achieving the lofty heights of last week's bonanza. All well finished cattle eagerly sought after and with leaner grassy types still achieving satisfactory returns with some of these over thirty months. More steers forward but with only a sprinkling of suckler-bred Continental sorts forward, best quality sold to 223p/kg, with heavy steers to £1461 in the lump. A sharp butchers heifer trade selling to 250p/kg with many others 240p/kg and above. Many good shaped beasts on the heavier side today, with breaking heifers to £1335.36. Some good bulls penned this morning saw trade holding firm, selling Continentals to 218p/kg with genuine Friesians to 199p/kg and all well finished bulls in demand.

8 COWS forward sold to a high of 168p/kg for 772kg Limousins, with British Blue crosses to 146p/kg for 714kg. 848kg Holsteins with meat sold to 138p/kg. Continue to send your cows before the autumn flush, should it materialise.

23 Steers sold to ov.av. 186p/kg – The Shropshire Jones stable took top spot here at 223p/kg for 608kg Limousin cross, with their 794kg Blondes to £1460.96. 548kg Limmies sold to 212p/kg for a 'deserving cause', with a beef Shorthorn to 205p/kg for the same vendor. 34 month Blues for Walter Davies sold to £1391.04.

65 Heifers sold to ov.av. 222p/kg - A cracking gang of heifers from the Jordin stabled headed the day at 250p/kg, closely followed by Richard Parkes and Simon Jones at 248p/kg - all handy-weights. Steve Perkins and Simon Raybould both achieved 245p/kg, with 536kg to 243p/kg from Tom Howells. Blues from the Truswells sold to £1335.36 for 642kg. Second quality well finished heifers very dear.
