Prime Cattle Report (Red)

157 PRIME CATTLE

A much improved entry of clean cattle with some quality sorts forward. There were fresh orders operating for the best cattle today along with our regular ring of buyers and produced a very sharp trade indeed. The overall market average of 211p/kg reflects the improved prices.

Only a handful of steers met a fantastic trade with 670kg Continentals selling to 252p/kg or £1688 in the lump. Butchers heifers met a 'flyer' selling to 271p/kg with five others above 260p/kg and numerous others 250p/kg and above. More commercial sorts met string demand, with Hereford heifers especially sought after.

Bull trade a little firmer generally, although bulls that are too old i.e. above 16 months and heavy meeting a difficult trade. Handy weight Continentals sold to 226p/kg at 480kg, with Charolais to 217p/kg for 738kg at 15m (£1601). Best fleshed young black and whites topped at 194p/kg for 524kg.

17 COWS & 2 STOCK BULLS

Some better meat cows forward saw trade no dearer. Best young Simmental cross cows sold to 144p/kg, with Blondes to 137p/kg for 692kg. Best meat dairy cows were not present but steaking sorts sold to 105p/kg at 832kg. Stock bulls saw a steady trade with crossbred Blonde to 99p/kg for 784kg and Angus 806kg to 104p/kg.

116 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 8 steers sold to average 225p/kg. Two superb Limousins from Robert Turner sold to 239p/kg and 252p/kg for 636kg and 670kg respectively. 702kg Charolais from Andrew Dalton sold to 221p/kg. 556kg Simmentals from Sam Howells also achieved 221p/kg with 600kg Lims to 220p/kg from Rita Corfield.

108 heifers sold to average 222p/kg. A cracking run of 7 from Richard Parkes sold to average 262p/kg to a high of 271p/kg for 488kg and 268p/kg for 496kg – both Limmies. 490kg Lims from Andrew Dalton sold to 261p/kg with a 588kg British Blue to 259p/kg (£1522) from Matt Bower. Numerous others sold above 250p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1744.22 for 736kg Blonde from David Preece. Herefords to 206p/kg from Roger Tomley.

41 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 184P/KG

16 Holsteins, Friesians etc. are included in the above average figure. 480kg Limousin from Dave Preece sold to 226p/kg at 18mths, with 502kg Blondes to 217p/kg from Bill Morgan. Heavy 738kg Charolais sold to 217p/kg from Glyn Breeze (£1601.46). Mary Beaumont sold Friesians to 194p/kg for 5424kg, with another to 186p/kg for 586kg also at 14mths.
