Fireworks in the beef department on Bonfire Night, with record prices for cattle outside Christmas Champion cattle. Only 36 clean cattle with eleven of these selling above two thousand pounds. Heifers sold to 400p/kg with twelve selling to 350p/kg or above!

Just into double figures for steers which met a very firm trade selling to 354p/kg or £2251 in the lump.

Heifers were simply `off the dial' to a top of 400p/kg or £2388 as a whole.

An increased entry of bulls saw a high of 318p/kg and with no heavy bulls, a top of £1966 was recorded.

10 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 312P/KG

Some very good meat steers penned this morning saw Evans Curdale cleaning up in all departments, with their 636kg red Limmie to 354p/kg (£2251.44). Handyweights from the Parkes family hit 350p/kg for 484kg, with Alan Forsyth and boys selling to 326p/kg for 568kg Limmie. Mrs B's run of meaty Angus and Simmentals topped at £2022 for 674kg.

A superb run from the Curdale stable set a recordbreaking high achieving 400p/kg for 546kg Limousins (£2184) with two others to 399p/kg and 398p/kg – the latter stacking up nicely at £2388!
