161 PRIME CATTLE

A much improved number forward following the Christmas holidays, saw a tremendous trade with buyers keen to secure cattle at the beginning of the first “normal” week. Although trade was not quite as fierce as last Tuesday’s bonanza, cattle still averages around the 200p/kg mark including several also-rans which were not available last week.

Steers sold to 234p/kg with bullocks still selling in front of deadweight quotations which have had to rise as of Monday morning because of live trade. There were no 700kg plus bullocks forward and £1502 was top price per head.

Heifers saw a bonanza once again with the best cattle regularly £100 + in front of dead weight quotes. Four cattle sold at 250p/kg or above to a top off 256p/kg. If heifers were well meated and not too fat they were wanted.

More bulls are wanted at the moment, obviously their situation has not been helped with what the “large players” did to the bull job 12 months ago. However, if you are feeding bulls then do a good job and you should reap the rewards. Only six suckler bulls sold to 233p/kg on two occasions. Proper Holsteins sold to 185p/kg.

25 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

More cows and a better trade. Meaty Friesians from Henry Yates sold to 120p/kg for 688kg and 660kg, with meated Blue crosses from Brian Watkins to 129p/kg for 690kg. 816kg Angus stock bulls to 98p/kg.

127 CLEAN CATTLE

25 steers sold to av. 199p/kg – Alastair Beedles headed this section with his Limousins 596kg hitting 234p/kg. 636kg and 656kg Limousins from Gerald Kincaid both sold to 229p/kg, with British Blues to 226p/kg from John Cantrill. Gordon Jones sold 650kg Lims to 224p/kg. Holstein steers sold to 160p/kg.

102 Heifers sold to average 199p/kg – Matt Bower was up in the lights today with his 488kg Limmies to 256p/kg. 538kg Limmies from Andrew Dalton took second spot at 253p/kg. Two smart heifers from Roger Jordin sold to 250p/kg and 252p/kg for beasts around half a tonne. 536kg Limmies realised to 248p/kg from Richard Parkes.

A very mixed bag of bulls included bulls over 4 years old and plenty of Holsteins with belly.

552kg and 586kg suckler Limousins from Frank Povall both sold

to 233p/kg to head this department. 586kg British Blues to 218p/kg from Simon Pennington. Bill Yeomans’ Blonde at 586kg sold to 206p/kg.

Harold Pugh sold Holsteins to 185p/kg, 182p/kg (x2) and 175p/kg for bulls around 550kg. Mary Beaumont sold to 183p/kg for 526kg.
