151 PRIME CATTLE

Trade continues to hold up well in the cattle department, with a very useful entry of meated cattle to satisfy our regular buyers. The very best cattle were probably no dearer but with middle of the road sorts seeing the uplift. A tremendous bull trade with Holsteins seeing exceptional demand with 176p/kg the bottom price!

A nice show of steers penned this morning saw best sorts to 266p/kg to a high of £1670 in the lump.

Butchers heifers in firm demand once again to 291p/kg, with all handyweight beasts very dear. Heavier females past £1600 on two occasions.

The bull trade was a revelation today with some tremendous sorts selling to 245p/kg on two occasions or to £1678 for heavier sucklers. Many Holsteins past 200p/kg today to a high of 211p/kg.

1 COW & 1 STOCK BULL

An 816kg Simmental cow with meat and belly sold to 138p/kg or £1126, with Simmental stock bulls at 850kg to 149p/kg (£1266.50). Stock bulls and cows needed each week!

98 CLEAN CATTLE

23 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 213P/KG

Starring Blondes from Frank Millichamp & Co sold to 266p/kg or £1670.48 for 628kg with 570kg Limousins from the Layton's to 250p/kg, with Blues to 245p/kg from the same home. A 544kg Limousin from Nev Taylor also sold well to 250p/kg.

75 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 239P/KG

A great run of mainly Limousins from Richard Parkes topped at 291p/kg for 476kg with plenty of others 260p/kg and above from the same house. Second spot went to Tony Baker with his homebred 494kg Limmie at 286p/kg. The Layton's sold two Lims to 282p/kg + 278p/kg with both around the 530kg mark. 594kg Limmies from Ed Bunning, who also upped his game today at £1609.74 in the lump. Other noticeable heifers sold to 270p/kg from Marks Pinches and 267p/kg from Mrs 'B'.

53 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV. 213P/KG

Bulls on fire today with some meaty sorts forward. The Layton family well represented in this section also selling twice to 254p/kg, with five steers 240p/kg and above from the same home.

Heavy Continentals sold to £1678.08 from Stuart Bebb. Black and White bulls were off the clock selling to 211p/kg from Steve Howells with Colin Evans selling to 210p/kg and Dan Hughes to the same. MORE BULLS COULD HAVE EASILY BEEN SOLD!

A large entry and the sale of the century averaging 324p/kg. Beltex hogs were well over 350p/kg to 366p/kg for 41kg from George Evans and £177 for 55kg hogs from Simon Pennington.

The exceptional average would have been more but for the 200+ Welsh hogs weighting 27kg to 32kg realising just under £3/kg. Better lightweights at 31kg to 336p/kg for Texels and 335p/kg for more hill types. Plenty of trade for hogs under 35kg.

Export spec hogs well up on last week, with more pens to mention over 350p/kg and very commercial 40kg hogs trading 220p/kg plus.

The biggest lift was for hogs over 48kg. Simon Wadlow's hogs at 48.5kg realised 355p/kg (£172) and Simon Pennington's 55kg hogs 320p/kg (£176). Pen after pen of 50kg hogs £3/kg plus.

Several consignments of hogs averaged over £150, with the higher averages toward £160 per head.

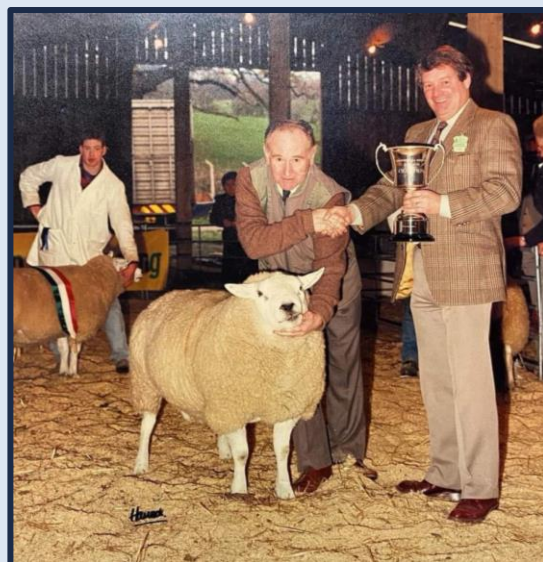
