### 147 PRIME CATTLE

A smaller post-Bank Holiday entry and a better sample of cattle forward. Trade looked a little better but in reality would be very similar to last week. Once again, in spec cattle created some interest whereas those cattle that did not tick all the boxes were less valuable. Our overall average of 175p/kg all in would look favourable against the dead weight quotations which were reduced considerably this week once again.

Some quality steers forward sold to a high of 197p/kg with heavies to £1306.80. Butchers heifers sold to a high pf 236p/kg with another to 234p/kg and many others above 220p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1254.96

Fewer bulls forward with some good suckler types and also some also ran black and whites. Heavy British Blues sold to 196p/kg.
