Similar numbers forward saw trade a little firmer with best sorts holding value as of recent sales, with bulls and more commercial clean easier to place. If this is the start of a rise, we better not count our chickens? Our normal buying contingent were in attendance as they have been throughout these stormy waters!

Steer prices were better, especially when you consider the big players refuse to budge on their prices. Handy-weights sold to 219p/kg and 218p/kg, with heavier bullocks to £1416.68.

More heifers could have easily sold today without affecting trade, seeing butchers quality selling to a high of 248p/kg, with numerous others 240p/kg and above. Few heavier females forward so £1256 was top call per head.

A little more life in the front of the bull section but too many over-lean bulls in front of the buyers today. Some good heavy bulls sold to £1490 and £1436, with handier weights to 195p/kg. Friesians sold to 154p/kg, with bulls required for the forthcoming Muslim festival.

7 COWS/STOCK BULLS

Great to see a few more barrens forward and with quality very mixed. Fit Limousins sold to 136p/kg for 634kg. Boning Friesians from 49p/kg-70p/kg. Meaty Shorthorn stock bulls to 110p/kg for 1024kg.

80 CLEAN CATTLE

24 Steers sold to ov.av.181p/kg – Shop Blue steers from Roger Jordin stole the honours here at 219p/kg, with 546kg Limmies to 218p/kg from Mrs B. 662kg Limousins sold to £1416.68, again for that deserving cause, with Charolais to £1274 from Mike Evans. Bullocks well sold when compared with supermarket demand.

56 Heifers sold to ov.av. 200p/kg – Richard Parkes sold his usual "magnificent seven" to 248p/kg for 504kg, with others to 247p/kg and 242p/kg. Early risers David Digwood & Co sold 492kg Limmies to 245p/kg, with Steve Perkins and The Thomas Bros selling to 244p/kg and 242p/kg respectively. Handy 476kg Limmies at lot one sold to 240p/kg from Mrs B once again. 530kg Lims sold to £1256.10 from Roger Jordin.

40 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 167P/KG

Young 578kg Limmies from Mark Jones topped at 195p/kg, with 768kg Lims to 194p/kg from Peter Kirton (£1489.92) and two others from the Kirtons sold to 188p/kg, with Bill Yeomans also achieving 188p/kg for 562kg.

A sharper black and white trade saw James Woolrich selling to 154p/kg and 152p/kg.
