Steers numbers were very tight and saw the best-selling to 277p/kg or £1717.40.

Four heifers sold above the magic 300p/kg to a high of 310p/kg, with heavy females selling well to £1808.

Twice as many bulls were required as trade here saw a lift, to highs of 264p/kg or £1695 in the lump. A great trade on black and whites, which sailed to 230p/kg.

No cows forward with trade on these on fire at the moment, with buyers looking for fat cows.

Not too many steers forward with the best shapes from Andrew & Neale Dalton selling to 277p/kg for 620kg Limmie. Blue crosses sold to 237p/kg from Frank Davies, with Fleckviehs to 223p/kg from Roger Rowson.

59 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 261P/KG

Dave Chilton stole the honours today with his Blonde selling to 310p/kg for 526kg. Richard Parkes was on DC's heels selling two to 308p/kg and 306p/kg respectively. Handyweight Limousins from the Dalton stable sold to 306p/kg and 299p/kg. Roger Jordan sold his heavy Limmies to £1807.92 at 648kg.
