## 1600 LAMBS

Just over 300 lambs forward in four classes for this year's Christmas show and sale which was judged by local Bridgnorth butcher, Mike Pearce (M&S Butchers) who awarded the George King Cup for overall champion pen, now in its 50<sup>th</sup> year, to Peter Morris whose Beltex lambs realised 335p/kg and backing his judgement not only by buying the champion pen but also the champion single lamb from Max Preece at 46kg selling to 298p/kg.

Trade throughout the show would be very acceptable with plenty of show lambs over 200p/kg. However, the commercial trade has taken a big drop in the last seven days with around £5/head taken out of the value of lambs.

Far too many over-weights on offer which are being discounted with handy, export weights still in demand but few and far between, with over three-quarters of the entry over 43kg.

Hill lambs to 166p/kg for 31.5kg, with Welsh to 150p/kg for 28kg.
