91 PRIME CATTLE

Decent numbers of clean cattle, but with several cattle too lean for the job. A sharp trade on the better steers and heifers, with that 300p/kg figure broached on several occasions. We were desperately short of bulls with some orders unable to get started. 30-50 bulls needed each week. We are expecting a normal market next Tuesday 13th December, so good entries will be required. Please keep in touch with the auctioneers with your potential cattle entries over the Christmas period, so we can inform buyers of the numbers and types coming forward.

There were some useful steers forward this morning with lightweights selling to 320p/kg with a top price per head of £1766.48 with no heavy weights penned. Heifers soared to 340p/kg with 16 others at 300p/kg or more. Heavy heifers fell just short of £2000 at £1924 in the lump.

A small show of bulls which were all dairy bred, bar three. Continentals topped at 234p/kg or £1596 in the whole. Decent square black and whites sold to 223p/kg.

Smart Limousins at 498kg from the Parkes family topped at 320p/kg. Other handy-weights from Phil Corfield sold to 290p/kg for 536kg. 622kg Limos from Cliff Amphlett sold to 284p/kg or £1766.48 in the lump.

63 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 261P/KG

A great run from Evans (Curdale) excelled at 340p/kg for 540kg Limo, with other red Limmies to 328p/kg, 325p/kg, 315p/kg for two and a Belgian Blue at 300p/kg for 592kg. Distance traveller Mr Willan sold to 315p/kg for 524kg Limousin, with Mrs B and Richard Parkes selling their best heifers to 314p/kg. 692kg Limmies from Clifford Amphlett stood out at £1923.76 (278p/kg). It is difficult to get your cattle too fit for our buyers at present.

16 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 203P/KG

658kg Limmies from James Williams sold to a reasonable go at 234p/kg, with his 700kg Limo at £1596 in the lump.
