Decent numbers of clean cattle, but with several cattle too lean for the job. A sharp trade on the better steers and heifers, with that 300p/kg figure broached on several occasions. We were desperately short of bulls with some orders unable to get started. 30-50 bulls needed each week. We are expecting a normal market next Tuesday $13^{\text {th }}$ December, so good entries will be required. Please keep in touch with the auctioneers with your potential cattle entries over the Christmas period, so we can inform buyers of the numbers and types coming forward.

There were some useful steers forward this morning with lightweights selling to $320 \mathrm{p} / \mathrm{kg}$ with a top price per head of $£ 1766.48$ with no heavy weights penned. Heifers soared to $340 \mathrm{p} / \mathrm{kg}$ with 16 others at $300 \mathrm{p} / \mathrm{kg}$ or more. Heavy heifers fell just short of $£ 2000$ at $£ 1924$ in the lump.

A small show of bulls which were all dairy bred, bar three. Continentals topped at $234 \mathrm{p} / \mathrm{kg}$ or $£ 1596$ in the whole. Decent square black and whites sold to $223 \mathrm{p} / \mathrm{kg}$.

What can only be described as a mediocre entry of lambs with far too many lean, under-finished sheep and Welsh sired lambs penned.

Best lambs just as dear as last week, with Texel lambs from Rob Jones 45 kg topping the day at $295 \mathrm{p} / \mathrm{kg}$ and for the second week in succession Sarah Levis' 50kg plus lambs selling to $£ 138.50$.

Heavier sheep seems easier to sell, but possibly a reflection of the level of finish rather than weight. Customers looking to buy finished, shapey lambs.

Lambs under 38 kg generally lacked finish and were of hill descent. With Welsh lambs just over 200p/kg, although Texel lambs weighing 35 kg sold to $255 \mathrm{p} / \mathrm{kg}$ from Rob Rose.
