More cattle needed today, with buyers looking to get started again following the Christmas festivities. Very best heifers not quite as fiery as New Year's Eve but with all other sorts more money. We hope the beef trade can maintain the momentum well into the New Year!

A handful more steers forward saw improved prices on the second quality, with best shapes to 214p/kg or £1468 in the lump.

Some nice quality heifers once again saw a top of 250p/kg, with numerous others 240p/kg or above. Heavy heifers sold to £1353.42.

Bull trade was a revelation with all shapes and sizes in demand. Continentals sold to 217p/kg, with heaving Conti's to £1651 in the lump. Black and White trade took a lift selling to 183p/kg with several over 120p/kg

No cows forward with buyers waiting. Fresh buying support coming towards the end of January.

Whilst on his holidays still Roger Jordin took top spot at 250p/kg for 530kg, with his others to 245p/kg and 247p/kg. One of the busiest starts to the New Year for many years with 2,200 sheep last week and 2,400 + this week. Trade stronger this week with hoggs averaging 211.6p/kg. Best lambs selling extremely well with butchers keen to refill their stocks after Christmas and the New Year.

A top price of 249p/kg for 42kg Texels from Andrew Meredith and a top price per head of £114 for the last pen of the day at 67kg from Richard Morgan.

Eleven customers bidding at the lambs representing eighteen firms ensuring trade across the board for all weights and grades, from the first to the last pen held firm, in fact more lambs could easily have been sold with no diverse effect.

Hoggs under 34kg sold to 226p/kg, 31kg hill lambs 208p/kg, 38kg to 44 kg hoggs most sought after and heavier sheep 46.5kg to 235p/kg, plenty 210p/kg to 220p/kg and the over 50's saw 55kg to 207p/kg and 53kg to 203p/kg.

Nationally the number of ewes forward well down on recent weeks so 600 ewes in Bridgnorth would be a very respectable entry and a sale average of £90.20 would compare to anywhere in the country.

The top price of £156 for Texels from Neil Ellis would be on a par with last week's high of £170 and the more commercial sheep possibly a little dearer with Suffolk x to £134 from Robert Lilley and North Country Mules well over £90 to £94.

Large plain ewes extremely dear with Suffolks £95 and £93, North Country Mules £70, Hill Ewes to £79, improved Welsh Beulah £72, Plain Hill Cheviots £62 and Mike Halford's Swales at £56.
