A much improved number penned this morning with few handy-weight plums forward. Several runs of beasts would have benefitted from a little more "corn bag" but the trade easily mopped these at very satisfactory values. Believe it or not, certain buyers still left short of cattle for their regular outlets today. Please keep the numbers coming, we have the buyers and you are getting the trade – beating the dead-weight on most occasions.

More steers forward saw a tidy level of trade throughout to 217p/kg for 646kg, with dead-weight centres looking to pull prices back 3-5p/kg this week and our trade would compare more favourably.

Best butchers heifers to 247p/kg with several above 240p/kg. Some of the best cattle were on the heavy side for the retail trade but still sold from 375p/kg-400p/kg dead-weight equivalent for the better sorts.

Bull numbers remain tight producing a buoyant trade. A distinct shortage of better types between 500kg and 600kg saw Continentals sell to 230p/kg. Friesians and Holsteins in strong demand selling to 166p/kg.

17 COWS FORWARD SOLD TO OV. AV. 120P/KG

A few more in this department which was very pleasing to see. Those attending were well-rewarded with a flying trade. Fed young Blonde cows sold to 197p/kg for 598kg, with Bazadaise 662kg to 157p/kg and Simmentals to 149p/kg for 708kg. 866kg Friesian cows sold to 130p/kg. Leaner steaking Holsteins to 115p/kg for 694kg.

Quality bulls thin on the ground as per recent sales. 500kg Blondes from Brian Watkins took the honours here at 230p/kg,


