

# BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET

## WEEKLY REPORT – 07.02.23



### 104 PRIME CATTLE

**Auctioneer – Mark Burgoyne 07831 192603**

A great show of clean cattle coupled with reasonable bull numbers produced a fantastic trade from start to finish! 22 cattle realised 300p/kg or above to a top of 335p/kg. Heifers sold to a high of £2047, red Hereford steers to £1794, Saler bulls to £2208 and Charolais stock bulls to £1710. There was strong demand for well-fleshed cattle and more could have easily sold to the awaiting throng.

Steer numbers were tight once again and included some very lean types. Best shapes sold to 308p/kg, with two others to 291p/kg. Hereford steers sold to £1784.02 in the lump.

Heifers were a superb show this morning selling to 335p/kg for handyweights, with heavy females carrying on from last week's humdinger at £2047 in the lump.

We are short of bulls at the minute with buyers looking to cheapen their clean cattle and consequently making bulls dearer. Best sucklers sold to 282p/kg with heavy Saler bulls to £2208 in the lump.

One small cow, on the plain side and non-assured, sold to 118p/kg, with Charolais stock bulls 1018kg selling to 168p/kg (£1710.24). More cows and stock bulls needed each week.

558kg Limmie steers from Evan Watkin headed this department at 308p/kg, with 608kg and 574kg Lims to 291p/kg from Dave Roberts. Blue steers with belly sold to 276p/kg from Mrs B. Rob Watkins' well-finished red Herefords stacked up nicely at £1794.02 for 662kg. Ultra-lean types would dilute the overall average figure.

Ian Morris topped the sale at 272p/kg for a 43kg Beltex, with Caroline Evans 40kg at 270p/kg. Heavier sheep to £152.60 for 62kg from Richard Morgan and hoggs under 40kg also showing significant improvement to 249p/kg, from Rob Rose for Continental sorts.

More Welsh bred hoggs easier to sell than last week, trading around 220p/kg.
