All the partners and staff of the firm held Mike in very high regard and he will be very sorely missed.

Really struggling for numbers today with everything in short supply. We had new customers today along with one or two, who have been selling dead-weight, which definitely shows how tight numbers could be out there. A very firm trade from start to finish with best cattle thinner on the ground.

A small show of steers saw the best to 208p/kg or to £1394 in the lump. There were some very lean cattle in this department. A deficit of butchers cattle sold to a high of 251p/kg with four others to 240p/kg. Commercial females a good trade with Hereford heifers in some demand. Heavy Continentals to £1365.12.

Less than 50 bulls with nine bidders for them! Suckler bulls with finish and shape in demand selling to a high of 219p/kg, with Friesian Holsteins a sharp trade selling to 169p/kg with no best Friesians penned this morning.

12 COWS & 2 STOCK BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 111P/KG

Cow trade was good once again with 712kg Limousins selling to 149p/kg and British Blues to 130p/kg. 622kg Friesians to 114p/kg. Jerseys very small this week and sold to 67p/kg. A storming trade on stock bulls with 1144kg Blondes to 139p/kg and 1004kg to 130p/kg.

70 CLEAN CATTLE

14 steers sold to average 180p/kg — Gordon Jones' Limousins topped this section at 208p/kg for 628kg, with his 774kg beasts to 184p/kg. Simmentals from the Raybould stable to 199p/kg with Lims from John Gore to 194p/kg, with Dave Whiteman's Limousin to 190p/kg. MORE STEERS REQUIRED EACH WEEK 56 heifers sold to av. 200p/kg — Richard Parkes' handy-weight Limousin topped the day at 251p/kg, with Jim Smith showing for the first time selling Limmies to 240p/kg on two occasions. Kevin Scott sold 536kg to 240p/kg with British Blues to 239p/kg.

Together with 650 ewes, a full sheep section of 2500 sheep. Trade slightly firmer averaging 172p/kg, with more demand for heavier hoggs which in recent weeks have been harder to sell. Best sheep over 200p/kg to 210p/kg for 38.5kg from MD & EA Evans closely followed by Clive Evans at 199p/kg!

Export weights generally 172p/kg to 178p/kg although this market seems, for whatever reason, to have cooled off.

44kg to 47kg, which have been difficult to sell, sold to 191p/kg and £88 from Sam Jones with 50kg plus hoggs to £86.50 from Richard Morgan.

Lighter weights varied in quality to 170p/kg for 28kg from Hayden Woolley with hill sheep 32kg to 168p/kg.

With larger entries of sheep, it would be helpful for the smooth operation of the market if vendors could arrive as early as possible. Gates open at 6am.
