A smaller Easter holiday entry saw trade mixed but perhaps a little firmer on some commodities. Although butchers have reported a busy Easter trade, some were reticent about having too much product lying around with a shorter week ahead this time. They should all be re-stocking next week.

Steer trade was similar with handy-weights selling to 200p/kg and heavier bullocks well in line or advanced of the further reduced deadweight quotes for this week. Heavy steers topped out at £1321.

A sharp trade on butchers cattle saw the best passed 240p/kg on two occasions to 243p/kg.

Several plain sorts helped deplete averages but the bull trade was generally firm with best sucklers to 216p/kg for 636kg. Friesian/Holsteins sold to 171p/kg and Norwegian Reds to 175p/kg.

20 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

A reasonable number forward but with plenty of ultra-plain sorts. Limousin crosses sold to 150p/kg for 582kg with others to 140p/kg. Meated Holsteins sold to 119p/kg from the Bowdlers, with Charlie Lloyd selling to 115p/kg for 738kg. Let's hope Charlie's shoulder mends up quickly following the recent surgery. Very lean Limousin stock bulls to 90p/kg.

ONLY 58 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 13 steers sold to average 182p/kg — with Scottish orders back on this morning, John Cantrill sold his 522kg Limousin to 200p/kg with Helen Shropshire-Jones selling 588kg to 191p/kg. 714kg Limousin crosses from John Rogers sold to £1320.90 with another £1242.50 from the same home. 774kg Holsteins from Sam Jones still sold to 30p less than £1200 — not so bad after all!

45 heifers sold to average 190p/kg — Charlie Sandells sold to 243p/kg for 472kg, just pipping Richard Parkes' 512kg model at 242p/kg (£1239.04).

46 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 169P/KG

A few "tail end Charlies" dented the average a little but this was basically a fair trade.

Best sucklers from Stuart Bebb sold to 216p/kg and 215p/kg for 636kg and 586kg Limousins. Joe Rodenhurst's cracking Blonde sold to 208p/kg, with Roger Tomley and Charlie Lloyd selling to 197p/kg.

Norwegian Reds from Colin Evans topped the dairy bulls at 175p/kg for 648kg.
