114 PRIME CATTLE

Less numbers forward following the Bank Holiday, saw trade holding its own generally, with some very well-meated cattle penned this morning which were a real credit to all producers in attendance.

A small sprinkling of steers which were well-fleshed sorts generally without necessarily being the best shapes. 215p/kg was the top shout or £1389 in the lump.

There was a deficit of handy-weight heifers this morning but a real good trade on 500-520kg cattle. Five cattle to 240p/kg and above, to a high of 248p/kg. Heavy females to £1324.

More bulls were required especially if well-finished. Handy-weights sold to 211p/kg, with heavy suckler bulls to £1428 and dairy bred heavies to £1321.

4 COWS

Four cows forward sold to a great trade and some quality sorts to boot. Limousin cows sold to 159p/kg and 154p/kg for 688kg and 680kg, with leaner types to 136p/kg. British Blues to 135p/kg.

69 CLEAN CATTLE

7 Steers sold to ov.av.191p/kg – Red Limmies headed this section at 215p/kg for 646kg for a very deserving cause, with Limmies crosses to 195p/kg at 676kg from the Whiteman Bros. Blue steers to 186p/kg for 610kg from Richard Ince.

62 Heifers sold to ov.av. 202p/kg – Mark Jones took top spot, with Blonde crosses to 248p/kg for 508kg. 528kg and 514kg Limmies from Roger Jordin both achieved 247p/kg, with half tonne Limmies to 244p/kg (x2) from Richard Parkes. Heavier heifers selling to £1325.84 for 672kg from Gordon Jones.

69 CLEAN CATTLE SOLD TO OV. AV. 177P/KG

A nice run of handyish weighted home bred cattle from the Rodenhursts sold to 211p/kg and 210p/kg, with Heart of England Farms selling to 207p/kg for 590kg. 752kg Limousins from Glyn Powell sold to £1428.50.

Friesians sold to 170p/kg from Henry Yates, with Colin Evans selling to 169p/kg and 166p/kg. Good demand for black and white bulls with flesh.
