140 PRIME CATTLE

A blistering trade throughout, with nowhere near enough cattle to satisfy demand. There were a ring full of buyers today, with many leaving short of cattle. An overall market average of 202p/kg resulted, with plenty of also rans, overagers and non assured cattle penned.

Steer numbers were fair and met a flying trade to 231p/kg or £1460.80 in the lump. Second string bullocks saw the biggest lift.

Butchers' heifers met a buoyant market with more selling above 240p/kg than for many months since. A top price of 247p/kg on three occasions. Few heavy females forward realising to £1380 per head.

The bull section began the day in fair fettle with Continentals selling to 225p/kg with many more above 200p/kg than we have seen for quite some time. Black & Whites were more mixed and sold to 170p/kg. Heavy bulls sold to just short of £1500.

13 COWS & 3 STOCK BULLS

A sharp trade here with more 'bums on seats' required.

Best Blonde cows sold to 170p/kg from Roy Kinnish or £1387.90 in the lump, British Blue x Friesians sold to 137p/kg for 744kg from Phil Clarke, 620kg Black & White cows sold to 131p/kg from Bill Rodenhurst, 804kg Irish Moile bulls to 109p/kg from Mr Haines, Highland bulls to 107p/kg from A Hill (Welsh Black bulls were missing!)

82 CLEAN CATTLE

40 Steers sold to an average 192p/kg - A cracking 560kg British Blue from Steve Perkins sold to 231p/kg, with a nice run from Richard Milner to 221p/kg for Blondes, 664kg Limousins sold to 220p/kg from Robert Jones.

42 Heifers sold to an average 212p/kg - Two Limousins from Richard Parkes topped the market at 247p/kg around the 500kg in weight, with a Limousin from Steve Perkins also achieving 247p/kg, 470kg Blondes from Brian Watkins finding Lot 13 lucky at 244p/kg, with 538kg Limousins selling to 243p/kg from Matt Bower. Blondes sold to 242p/kg from Roy Kinnish.

59 BULLS SOLD TO AV 190p/kg

A very sharp trade all through saw Roger Rowson heading the section at 225p/kg for 592kg. 562kg Blondes sold to 219p/kg from Brian Watkins, with Lee Preece selling 632kg Limousins to 219p/kg. Roger Tomley sold 4 bulls to 216p/kg, with Frank Povall achieving the same.

Black & Whites topped at 170p/kg from James Woolrich.
