151 PRIME CATTLE

Fewer cattle forward with twenty less than last week. Trade generally a little easier but still in front of dead quotes which remained static or reduced at the beginning of the week. Our overall average of 178p/kg included a very poor sample of Holstein bulls not hidden in the figures!

Good quality steers sold well and were probably the pick of today's trade selling to 209p/kg. Butchers heifers were a good price but without the 'bite' of recent sales. Top heifers sold up to 240p/kg.

A very mixed sample of bulls with plain Holsteins to the fore. Heavy Continentals sold to 198p/kg with quality bulls in very short supply. More well-finished bulls are needed for waiting lorries. Friesian Holsteins sold to 170p/kg.

22 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO AVERAGE 83P/KG

A realignment of cow prices started the end of last week as numbers gather momentum as autumn arrives. This 'back end' trade has been anticipated, it was just when not if. Buyers wanted cheap cows or no cows at all.

Young dry bagged cows sold to 130p/kg, with older sucklers to 124p/kg. Meat Friesians sold to 96p/kg. Lean Holstein stock bulls 60p/kg.

86 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 14 steers sold to av. 182p/kg – Two well-finished Continentals from Charlie Sandells sold to 209p/kg and 208p/kg, both handy weights. Charolais from Vincent Evans sold to 198p/kg for 618kg. There were several over thirty month cattle forward with 722kg to 179p/kg from Vincent Evans once again.

Only 74 Heifers sold to average 201p/kg – A firm overall trade saw 536kg Limousins to 240p/kg from Matt Bower. British Blues from Roger Jordin sold to 239p/kg at 536kg. George Evans, Steve Perkins, Neil Perkins, Richard Parks and Jean Kirkham all sold to 230p/kg and above. There were also several females over thirty months forward.

63 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 152P/KG

A very ordinary bull entry generally contributed to the above average with runs of Holsteins brethren better suited to a store sale!

Dave Preece's 502kg Limousin sold to 198p/kg to top the section. 654kg Limousins from James Woolrich sold to 195p/kg, with his 732kg British Blue to 185p/kg. 658kg Charolais to 192p/kg from Dave Preece.
