158 PRIME CATTLE

It was great to see more clean cattle penned this morning and there was a trade to match, with all clean cattle including Holstein heifers over 36 months averaging 210p/kg. A ring packed full of buyers saw competition for all shapes and sizes with some butchers unable to fulfil regular orders. Good entries will be required next week.

Only a small show of steers saw the best to 231p/kg or £1513 in the lump. More well-fleshed bullocks could have easily sold today.

Butchers heifers were a revelation again selling to 266p/kg and passed 260p/kg on five other occasions. Heavy females sold to £1557, with plenty of over-agers and also rans to deplete averages. Farm assurance or the number of passport movements did not have any bearing on value here!

The worst show of bulls for months met a similar trade with abattoirs trying to pull prices back on these. Several producers were having a tidy up of their tail end bulls today hence our average below 160p/kg!

Best bulls very thin on the ground and sold to 207p/kg, with most Continentals over 16 months and 650kg plus.

20 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Farm assured cows with meat in strongest demand once again selling to 148p/kg for 634kg British Blues, with younger Limousins to 144p/kg. 718kg meaty Friesians sold to 123p/kg with 748kg to 118p/kg. Non-assured Holsteins with flesh sold to 109p/kg. 1206kg Blonde stock bulls to 105p/kg.

102 CLEAN CATTLE

17 steers sold to av. 203p/kg – It was great to see Frank Millichamp back in the harness with his 552kg Blonde steer heading the way at 231p/kg. 630kg Limousin from Gerald Kincaid to second spot at 221p/kg, closely followed by Dave Chilton's 632kg Limmie at 220p/kg.

85 heifers sold to av. 211p/kg — A superb run of 14 from Richard Parkes sold to 266p/kg but averaged 248p/kg all through! Handy 406kg Lims from Matt & Wendy Bower sold to 261p/kg, with Kevin Scott returning after a long absence to achieve 260p/kg for 528kg. Charlie Sandells sold two crackers to 260p/kg also, with a "very deserving cause" selling to 250p/kg and 252p/kg for Limmies at lot 1 and 2. 646kg British Blues sold to 241p/kg from Phil Clarke (£1557).

With the deadweight centres trying to reduce prices this week, it is to be hoped that more clean find their way to the live market because they are definitely needed and worth more money.

50 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 157P/KG

40 bulls were either Holsteins, Ayrshires, Brown Swiss or Friesians today. Best Friesian bulls sold to an improved trade to 177p/kg for Peter Wright. Only a handful of suckler bulls sold to 207p/kg for 668kg Limousins from Todd Harris. 576kg sold to 202p/kg from John Cantrill. More well-finished bulls were desperately needed with hopefully the pre-winter clear out almost complete.


