Met a firm trade selling to 128p/kg on meated Angus cows, 870kg with leaner Limousin-crosses to the same for 698kg.

72 CLEAN CATTLE (INCLUDING SHOW CATTLE)

22 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 273p/kg

A blistering show of steers met a cracking trade with second prize steers selling to 350p/kg for 570kg from Sarah Layton and purchased by Neville Wickstead. The Laytons were also in the money again with their 530kg British Blue at 310p/kg bought by our Judge John Rutter. 588kg Limousins from Edward Howells sailed to 300p/kg, 688kg Limmies added up nicely from Bob Beaman at £1996.40 or 290p/kg.

50 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV.AV 268p/kg

Mrs B had a good day outside the show selling her best two to 326 and 320p/kg for one Blue and one Limousin around the half-ton. Dan Watkins' Blonde sold to 322p/kg for 482kg with Evans (Curdale) selling 558kg to 320p/kg (£1785.60) 604kg Limousins from David Chilton sold to £1746.54.

95 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV 220p/kg

The champion bull from the Layton stables, a British Blue, sold to 278p/kg for 514kg and was purchased by R. Pearson. Second prize was a Limmie presented by IGC Morris, which realised 274p/kg for 582kg. Outside the show a 654kg Limousin from Will Forrester sold to 275p/kg, with his heaviest bull 934kg selling to £2232.26.

A good go on the black and whites once again with Simon Pennington selling to 215p/kg for 466kg. Dairy bulls were generally plain today.

Continental ewes most sought after with Charollais ewes from Dave Roberts to £188 and Texels from Richard Morgan £161. Strong Suffolk ewes short in supply to £136 again from Dave Roberts

A drove of North Country Mules sold around £90 to £109 with plenty of plainer Mules which traded generally over £60 for the worst, however with most £70 plus.

Half the entry would comprise of hill or smaller breeds with Exmoor Horn to £100, smaller horns £80, Swales to just short of £70, small Scotch Blackface £68.50, small Welsh £68 and Radnors £85.

A good entry of lambs was put forward for the Christmas Fatstock Show and Sale, in both quantity and quality.

Trade through the Sale would be similar to last week, with better sorts a little dearer but more ordinary lambs perhaps a little harder work.

Judged this year by Mark Perrins of Farmers Fresh, awarding both the Brian Meredith Cup for best single lamb and the George King Cup for overall Champion pen to Lee Preece. The single Beltex lamb weighted 40kg reaching 600p/kg £240 purchased by Mr Akram, Chairman of Pak Mecca Meats, Birmingham and the Champion pen 43kg 610p/kg was purchased by local Bridgnorth butchers Mike and Sarah, M&S Butchers.

Reserve Champion John Hughes 47kg Beltex realised 425p/kg and was sold to Mr Akram.

Top price per kilo outside of the Show was 339p/kg for a 40kg Beltex from George Evans and highest price outside the Show £153 for Andrew Preece.

A very good entry of cattle for the time of year, met a buoyant trade from start to finish.

The dispersal of the Hurcott Herd of Charolais cows and calves stole the headlines selling well especially so as more of the cows had run with a bull for some time. A six-year old cow with a young heifer calf sold to £1700. Other outfits were split with cows with strong calves trading at £2640, £2480, £2030, £1800, £1470 and £1745. Young Charolais bulls sold to £870. Heifers with very young Angus calves sold for £1100 from Mr Mann, with Simmentals with young twin calves for £1150. British Blue cross steers sold to £1090 from Ryan Pugh, with his Blue heifers sailing to £1120. Five red Limmie steers from Mr Mann sold to 291p/kg with his Limmie best heifers to 280p/kg.
