WEEKLY REPORT – 08.01.19



154 PRIME CATTLE

Following last week's bonanza, a more realistic trade resulted, with all buyers returning needing cattle following the Christmas break. Best cattle in strong demand still but with plainer more commercial types harder to place.

More steers penned this morning saw best handy weights to 230p/kg, with heavy Continentals to £1449 in the lump.

Butchers heifers passed 250p/kg once again to a high of 252p/kg. Fewer heavy heifers forward sold to £1362. Good entries of well-finished clean cattle required each week.

The bull trade held out well and was at least as dear as last week. Best shaped Continentals sold to 220p/kg, with heavy bulls to £1453. Black and whites sold equally well to a high of 179p/kg and £1100 in the lump.

11 COWS FORWARD SOLD TO OV. AV. 90P/KG

A little more "bite" in this trade but still nothing too spectacular. Best Limousins available sold to 125p/kg (£927.50) with Salers to 114p/kg for 770kg. Plain cows a steady market from 25p/kg for Jerseys to 75p/kg for Blue crosses.

99 CLEAN CATTLE

20 Steers sold to ov.av.180p/kg – Handy Limousin from Roger Jordin stole the honours here at 230p/kg, with Blondes from Frank Millichamp to 215p/kg for 674kg. Rita Corfield-McCowan sold her Limmies to 206p/kg for 614kg, with 664kg to 202p/kg from Alastair Beedles.

79 Heifers sold to ov.av. 205p/kg – A star from Andrew Craig saw best advantage at 252p/kg, with Blondes from Forest Vale Growers to 250p/kg at 514kg. Richard Parkes' usual run achieved 248p/kg for 506kg for his best, with Roger Jordin and Frank Millichamp selling heavier heifers both to 246p/kg. Many others above 235p/kg.

All well-finished heifers see plenty of demand – don't sell them too lean!

55 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 173P/KG

Limousins from IGC Morris sold to 220p/kg and 216p/kg for 594kg and 634kg respectively, with Tom Hall also achieving 216p/kg for 614kg. Blues from Rob Hartley sold to 215p/kg, with 536kg to 214p/kg from Bill Yeomans. 794kg Charolais from Charlie Cadwallader stacked up to £1453.02.

Thick meat Friesians sold to 179p/kg from James Woolrich and to £1100 in the lump. Plenty of bulls around 170p/kg mark.
