132 PRIME CATTLE

Auctioneer – Martin Clack 07977 067519

A few more cattle than last week, despite some very small entries forward on Monday. 56 bulls with an average of 207p/kg a reflection of the quality, with very few suckler bulls out today.

Clean cattle a little easier to sell with heifers averaging 245p/kg and only 6 steers with a price range of 130p/kg from top to bottom. Shapey sorts remain the order of the day with butchers bidding up for quality.

Steers to 250p/kg and £1461.50 with a third of the steers on offer over 30 months. Butcher's heifers to 311p/kg and 300p/kg at £1729 and £1722 in the lump and all from Andrew Bishop.

Realistically a good entry of bulls, although more bulls could easily be sold every week. Suckler bulls to 257p/kg with black and whites 203p/kg to 207p/kg for squarer bulls and £1644.80. A number of heavier bulls well over £1500.

76 CLEAN CATTLE

6 STEERS SOLD TO AVERAGE 188P/KG

A top of 250p/kg for a handy weight 538kg Limmy from Brian and Dave Whiteman. Heavier steers 648kg at 226p/kg from Rita Corfield for £1464, Holstein steers (31 months old), at £894.

70 HEIFERS SOLD TO AVERAGE 245P/KG

Andrew Bishop's pair of Limmies took top spot at 311p/kg and 300p/kg, adding up to over £1700 a piece with the pick of Roger Jordin's heifers at 294p/kg. Marcus Whitehouses's smart heifers ensured no-one left until the last beast sold at 289p/kg.

More dairy bred cattle seemed a little easier to sell from last week, with well-finished, meated cattle in demand.

56 BULLS SOLD TO AVERAGE 207P/KG

Suckler bulls from Bill Yeoman took top honours at 257p/kg with another pair of Blondes at 246p/kg and 247p/kg.

Heavy weight bulls were £1644, with bulls 630kg to 800kg over the £1500 mark.

Friesian bulls to 206p/kg from Simon Pennington, most on or around the 200p/kg mark, with Belgian Blue x Friesian bulls to 234p/kg from Rob Whiteman.

A larger entry than expected with hogs from all corners of the county and a firm trade, considering the variety of sheep on offer.

21 hogs donated for Prostate Cancer UK sold to 430p/kg for 42kg from Stuart Moss, with a number over the 400p/kg and £180.

A top price in the normal sale of 327p/kg for a super pen of Texel hogs from Andrew Meredith and heavier Texels at 321p/kg from Steve Perkins.

Trade on hogs under 44kg stronger than last week, with quite lean 40kg plus hogs towards 180p/kg and over 500 hogs under 38kg selling to a very brisk trade, with quality mixed and the better sorts over 300p/kg. Welsh 30.5kg at 259p/kg and Continentals generally 265p/kg to 280p/kg.
