165 PRIME CATTLE

Trade very mixed but with nearly as many steers as heifers forward, with runs of Angus and Herefords types amongst these. Once again, handy-weight butchers cattle between 480kg and 520kg thin on the ground and these sold to a premium.

More bullocks forward saw handy-weights to 208p/kg on two occasions, with heavies to £1341.60. Plenty of runs of native breeds on the thicker side of lean sold from 155p/kg - 170p/kg generally.

Quality handy heifers were is short supply with the best heifers generally 530kg upwards and sold to 233p/kg on two occasions. More heifers required next week.

Best quality bulls very hard to come by, with those that were available making decent prices. Limousins headed the day at 219p/kg and 217p/kg, with strong demand on 500kg - 600kg well-finished young bulls. Heavier bulls to £1351.42 in the lump.

The black and white section lacked quality generally with good square bulls to 162p/kg.

ONLY 7 COWS SOLD TO AV. 109.4P/KG

Disastrously low cow numbers saw a very useful trade with 666kg British Blue cross sucklers to 119p/kg, with 730kg Simmentals to 114p/kg. Meated slip Holsteins sold to 112p/kg, with 834kg meat Friesians to 109p/kg.

MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS NEEDED WITH 4 BUYERS BIDDING AROUND THE RING TODAY

110 CLEAN CATTLE

52 steers sold to av. 175p/kg – Handy-weight British Blues and Lims from Charlie Sandells and a "very deserving cause" topped this department at 208p/kg, with heavier Limmies from Rob Turner to 207p/kg at 644kg. Both Phil Roberts and Gerald Kincaid sold over 200p/kg also, with Steve Jones' 688kg Limousin stacking up at £1341.60.

58 heifers sold to av. 189p/kg — Richard Parkes topped the market with two Limmies at 233p/kg for 538kg and 494kg. 512kg British Blues sold to 231p/kg from Roger Rowson. Heifers from 550kg — 600kg saw improved returns as long as they weren't too fat. More lean, shapey cattle could have been sold to advantage.

55 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 160P/KG

Once again, a strong Holstein influence here along with some over 30 month brethren. Stuart Bebb headed up the day with his 528kg Limousin at 219p/kg. 590kg Limousins sold to 217p/kg from Mark Pinches, with 514kg Blondes to 214p/kg from Brian Watkins. Two Limmies 686kg and 688kg sold above £1300 from Todd Harris.

Dave Evans's Friesians sold to 162p/kg and 160p/kg for 538kg and 500kg respectively, with Phil Roberts and Gilbert Brown selling dairy bulls to 154p/kg.
