Once again a slip in trade following on from the large abattoirs dropping their deadweight quotations on Monday morning. As the auctioneer envisaged last week, there was little Jewish demand today, so consequently heavier steers and heifers saw easing prices with only the very best holding their own. Overall market average including bulls and cattle over thirty months was 172p/kg.

Depleted cow numbers once again with 3 buyers in attendance. Blonde cross cows sold to 148p/kg for 814kg from Pete Raybould. Cows look well sold against the clean trade.

MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS ARE REQUIRED

152 CLEAN CATTLE

62 steers sold to average 170p/kg. Steers outside of the show sold to 212p/kg for 616kg from John Johnstone, with Gerald Kincaid's Limousins selling to 203p/kg for 650kg. More commercial cattle met a bottomless trade, especially if too fat or heavy.

90 heifers sold to average 182p/kg. A decent trade on butchers heifers saw females outside of the show selling to 228p/kg for 500kg from Dave Chilton, with Rob Pugh and Rob Hartley selling to 226p/kg. Butchers cattle saw plenty of demand whereas heavier thick heifers were not really required.

Trade still very firm carrying on from last week, with heavy weights a little dearer selling to £115 per head and 241p/kg, with several consignments averaging £105 per head with one load of Charollais hoggs averaging £107.

Quality better this week with a run of fed hoggs with plenty of weight 50kg plus, generally over £2/kg to 220p/kg for 51kg Texel x and 53.5kg Charollais to 205p/kg.

Handy weights a very sharp trade to 241p/kg for 43.5kg and several pens over 230p/kg, notably 47.5kg at 237p/kg from Henry Yates.,

Light weights to 212p/kg for 31.5kg Texels and hill lambs £2/kg to 208p/kg.

The Easter Show sponsored by Allflex tags and judged by David Partridge saw an entry of 80 lambs average 279p/kg to 322p/kg and £130 per head.

First prize was awarded to RC Evans for 37kg realising 310p/kg and 2nd prize to CO Watkins for 39.5kg realising 322p/kg, purchased by CE Partridge, Bromsgrove and Allan Bennett, Codsall.

First prize hoggs went to Nigel Kinsey for 43.5kg at 241p/kg and joint second prize went to Henry Yates and Bill Morgan for 42.5kg and 40.5kg at 240p/kg.
