## Prime Cattle (Red)

### 144 PRIME CATTLE

Trade was very similar to last week, but with more ordinary cattle forward. With many deadweight centres reducing their quotations by 2-3p/kg, our clean cattle would be well in advance of this. Our overall average of 164p/kg included over age Dexter steers and more cattle over 30 months than recent weeks.

Very few decent steers penned with only one over 200p/kg at 212p/kg or £1395 in the lump. Butchers heifers were a sharp trade selling to 231p/kg with heavier heifers up to £1270 per head.

Bull trade was very selective once again with best handy weights to 199p/kg and 198p/kg. There were plenty of customers for the lesser end types.

### 26 COWS & 2 STOCK BULLS SOLD TO AV. 111P/KG

A larger compliment in this section and a good trade resulted with 3 buyers attending.

Devon cross cows from Pete Raybould sold to 138p/kg for 736kg, with 600kg slips to 132p/kg. Red Herefords sold to 121p/kg for 606kg. Very few meat dairy cows with the best available to 114p/kg for 720kg. Plain cows from 64p/kg-82p/kg generally. British Blue stock bulls sold to 136p/kg for 820kg.

### 92 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 23 steers sold to average 152p/kg. Limousins from James Woolrich at 658kg sold to 212p/kg to head this section, with his 578kg Limousin to 195p/kg. 622kg British Blues for Mr Wardle sold to 190p/kg, with 13m Simmentals to 189p/kg at 556kg from Charlie Sandells. There were several Holsteins and dairy Shorthorns forward selling from 100p/kg – 133p/kg.

Only 69 heifers sold to average 187p/kg. A good run of Continentals from Dave Chilton topped the day at 231p/kg for 504kg, with another Blonde to 228p/kg. Simon Jones' and Richard Parkes' runs both excelled at 225p/kg with the Parkes stable also achieving 224p/kg. Steve Perkins' two handy weight Lims both achieved 220p/kg. Small, plainer sorts helped to reduce overall averages dramatically.

### 52 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 144P/KG

There were 25 Holsteins/Shorthorns forward this morning. Two super Blondes sold to 199p/kg and 198p/kg from Brian Watkins at 478kg and 516kg. 594kg Simmentals sold to 185p/kg from Charlie Sandells. 608kg Blondes sold to 180p/kg from Charlie Cadwallader.
