More Cattle penned this morning with some fresh orders for clean cattle helping trade. Overall, prices were perhaps a little easier on the best heifers but with breaking cattle at least as dear as last week. Once again, plenty of “out of spec” cattle not suiting most abattoirs, selling pretty well.

Steers of all shapes and sizes met similar returns, with best sorts selling to 219p/kg or £1382.00 in the lump. Plain Holsteins helped to deplete averages with over-agers a good trade.

A tremendous show of heifers saw the best to 246p/kg, with 470kg - 530kg with shape and finish in strong demand. Heavier sorts sold to £1288.20.

GOOD ENTRIES OF CLEAN REQUIRED EACH WEEK PLEASE.

Bull trade was very sharp again, with best handy-weights to 226p/kg on two occasions. Heavier bulls sold to £1349.00 in the lump, with black and whites tending to have belly selling to 170p/kg.

8 COWS saw another buoyant trade with young Blonde cows (43m) selling to 180p/kg (£1339.20.) Hereford cows to 144p/kg for 740kg. Strong Holstein steakers 756kg to 125p/kg.

102 CLEAN CATTLE

22 Steers sold to ov.av. 183p/kg – Matt & Wendy Bower’s Limousins sold to 219p/kg and 216p/kg for 604kg and 556kg respectively, with Charlie Sandells’ handy 526kg Limmie to 219p/kg. Others from John Johnstone also sold to 216p/kg for 536kg. Holsteins to 160p/kg from David Cantrill.

80 Heifers sold to ov.av. 208p/kg – A cracking Limousin 498kg from Wallace Jones sold to 246p/kg, with Richard Parkes’ useful run topping out at 245p/kg for 514kg. Andrew Craig’s and Roger Jordin’s half ton females both achieved 241p/kg, with the Jones’ 570kg Limmie selling to £1288.20. Several Hereford crosses sold passed 200p/kg to 207p/kg from Julian Aston. Breaking up heifers very dear.

50 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 185P/KG

There were some useful Continentals forward today with Stuart Bebb and Jan Edwards both selling to 226p/kg for 550kg and 522kg respectively, with Mrs Edwards also selling to 220p/kg and 218p/kg. 536kg Limousins sold to 216p/kg from Howard Fish and to 214p/kg for Charlie Sandells. Saler crosses to 213p/kg from Howard Mold and Simmentals to the same from Andrew Bryan. 688kg Simmentals to £1348.48 also from the Bryan stable.

A good Friesian from Henry Yates sold to 170p/kg (£1122) with Julian Aston selling to 167p/kg. Colin Evans sold his black and whites to £1056.
