A belting trade although as major abattoirs chop values once again! Not enough cattle to satisfy buyers and viable haulage. There were some fantastic cattle forward and with some new vendors trying out the live ring - I think they will be back. 15 out of 42 clean cattle sold to 300p/kg or more, to a top of 342p/kg.

Only a small compliment of steers saw a top of 288p/kg or £1974 in the lump. Well-finished bullocks sold above deadweight values.

Butcher-weight heifers sold to a fantastic 342p/kg with 3 others above 330p/kg, with shapey, heavy females to £1923.

A very small sample of bulls saw trade in front of other centres with heavy suckler bulls selling to 274p/kg or £1901 in the lump. Holstein Friesians are becoming a rare commodity these days.

A very shapey but leanish Blue steer from Keith Tolley sold to 288p/kg for 596kg, with handy weight 524kg Limousins to 274p/kg from Phil Edwards. Mr Willan's well-finished Welsh Black cross 774kg added up nicely at £1973.70.

#### 35 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 287P/KG

Smart handy weight Limmies from Neil & Josh Perkins stole the headlines at 342p/kg for 480kg, closely followed by three super Lims from Evans Curdale at 336p/kg, 334p/kg and 332p/kg - all over 500kg. Steven & Rhys Perkins are worthy of note with a cracking black heifer at 324p/kg for 486kg with a well-finished Blonde from Mrs B at 320p/kg for 544kg breaking the Lim monopoly. 654kg Limmie Blues from Phil Edwards added up to the most at £1922.76 (294p/kg).

Heavy lambs remain dear with the overall sale average more than the SQQ which makes no sense of most deadweight grids. Burwarton Farms 57kg lambs topped at £158.10 and 52.5kg lambs from the same farm at 282p/kg. Lambs under 40kg to 288p/kg for 38kg Texels from Mark Steele.
