103 PRIME CATTLE

With the pressure on to get the harvest wrapped up, there was a deficit of numbers forward this morning. A blistering trade on clean cattle with bulls maintaining values easily. Plenty of buyers around the ring produced very competitive bidding with all cattle averaging 201p/kg.

Only a sprinkling of steers did not help filling orders with a top price of 219p/kg and no best bullocks forward.

The heifer trade was simply “off the clock” with the cream selling to 260p/kg, with six others 250p/kg and above. Heavy females added up well to £1410.

Fewer bulls forward saw a similar trade and saw best suckler types to 216p/kg and heavies to 213p/kg. Dairy bulls were not last week’s quality but still sold to 177p/kg.

10 COWS SOLD TO AV. 96P/KG

A mixed bag of cows with Farm Assurance becoming more important. Even the buyers who can take non-assured cows prefer them FABBL.

Best Limousins available sold to 136p/kg for 648kg, with others to 126p/kg. Plenty of boners penned that depleted averages selling on the 60-70 pence’s.

61 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 4 steers sold to av. 170p/kg – It goes without saying that more bullocks were needed on this trade. British Blue crosses 594kg from David Cantrill sold to 210p/kg only to be aced by Marianne & Ray Bason’s handy-weight Limmie at 219p/kg. Holsteins to 158p/kg from Simon Pennington.

57 heifers sold to av. 221p/kg – A tremendous run of a dozen from Richard Parkes sold to average 249p/kg to a high of 260p/kg for 458kg, with five others 250p/kg and above. Roger Jordin’s 504kg model sold to 250p/kg, with the Bason stable selling 510kg to 248p/kg. Simon Pennington and Roger Jordin sold heifers above £1400 per head. More commercial sorts sold well in advance of the competition with 50m cattle in the averages.

42 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 170P/KG

A tidy trade with some mixey sorts forward. Roger Tomley’s nice run was headed by a 584kg Limousin at 216p/kg, with Matt Bower selling 646kg and 652kg to 213p/kg also Limousins. 640kg Blondes from Howard Mold hit 199p/kg with handier weights to 198p/kg and 197p/kg from Richard Morgan and Rita Corfield. Holsteins from Joe Rodenhurst topped the dairy bulls at 177p/kg, with Montbeliarde to 167p/kg from Simon Pennington.

Heavy lambs to 171p/kg for 46.5kg from Sam Jones. Generally heavy weights realising no less per kilo. 64kg Texels to £102.40 with 50kg plus lambs averaging £86 per head.

Rams remain dearer than ewes at £97. Horned £94 lean Texels and £84 lean Charollais.
