Prime Cattle Report (Red)

138 PRIME CATTLE

Depleted numbers once again, with plenty of meat cattle penned but not all necessarily the best shapes. A very sharp trade resulted to produce an overall average of 197p/kg all through. More cattle are needed to satisfy regular orders.

Only a sprinkling of steers forward with few suckler bred cattle amongst them. Top price was 227p/kg or £1498.20 for a continental over 30 months of age. Heifers sold passed 260p/kg on two occasions to a high of 264p/kg with heavy heifers passed £1500 per head.

Although one buyer down, a pretty good bull trade resulted with heavy continentals to 235p/kg or £1593 in the lump. Holstein bulls with meat sold easily above 160p/kg to a high of 208p/kg.

ONLY 11 COWS SOLD TO AV. 110P/KG

Cow trade is fairly lack lustre with a lack of demand not helping matters – perhaps some colder weather may help? 730kg Limousin cows sold to 140p/kg from Roger Payton with 736kg Limmies to 129p/kg for Gordon Jones. No best Holsteins forward today but the best available sold to 108p/kg for Phillip Price.

87 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 14 steers sold to average 191p/kg. Shropshire & Jones sold two Limousins to 227p/kg and 210p/kg, both OTM, to head this section. 558kg Lims from Ray Bason sold to 218p/kg, with Charolais from Phil Roberts selling to 214p/kg for 614kg. Herefords to 184p/kg (x2) from Kytes Nest to fulfil local butchers' orders.

73 heifers sold to average 214p/kg. Dave Chilton stole the show with his 478kg Limousin at 264p/kg, with another sweet heifer from Neil Perkins closely following at 261p/kg. 582kg Blondes from Matt Bower sold to 257p/kg but with David Preece's Charolais totalling a little more at £1507 for 670kg. Jean Kirkham sold two handy females to 255p/kg and 250p/kg. Herefords sold to 211p/kg from Ed Bunning.

ONLY 51 YOUNG BULLS SOLD TO AV. 176P/KG

30 Holsteins. Friesians etc. are included in today's average. A superb 678kg Blonde from Charlie Cadwallader hit 235p/kg or £1593.30. Handy weight Limousins from Graham Barker sold to 229p/kg, with 540kg Blondes to 220p/kg for 540kg from Brian Watkins with another to 214p/kg, again from the 'Mayor' of Powkesmore. Holsteins sold to 208p/kg from Graham Potter with Friesians to 197p/kg from Henry Yates.
