

# BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET WEEKLY REPORT – 08.10.19



## 136 PRIME CATTLE

Unless you have got best heifers which are the right weights, trade was extremely hard work. Kosher trade has stopped for the time being as they holiday, so any steam that might have been created is missing. Too many cattle being sold below the cost of production to be sustainable long term, with plenty of imported beef floating around making life more difficult.

Some decent steers about this morning sold to 198p/kg or to £1338 in the lump.

Heifers sold to 248p/kg with four others above 240p/kg. Heavier females sold to £1314.

Bull trade pretty steady also but no less than recent weeks with best shaped continentals to 200p/kg with heavies to £1376. Square Friesians sold to 165p/kg with Holstein's seldom past 150p/kg.

### ONLY 8 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 188P/KG

Good Limmies 676kg sold to 198p/kg from Roger Jordin with another a little lighter to the same. British Blues sold to 188p/kg from Keith Tolley with Charolais to 187p/kg from a 'very deserving cause'.

### 72 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 183P/KG

A useful run from Edward Howells sold nicely from 235p/kg to 248p/kg from 508kg to 530kg, with 530kg Limousines' to 246p/kg from Steve Davies. Others sold to 242p/kg from Roger Jordin. Heifers passed £1300 from IGC Morris and Edward Howells. Bottom end heifers cheap but not really wanted unless they were!

A similar number of lambs to last week and an identical average although trade this week would be firmer, not replicated in the average due to the large amount of poorly finished lambs under 40kg. A top price per kilo this week of 195p for 40kg Texel lambs from both Peter Kirton and Lee Preece but the general trade on the best lambs would be no better.

Commercial export type sheep dearer by around 5ppkg most 170p/kg to 175p/kg with heavier sorts 46kg to 178p/kg and £94.20 from Sarah Levi, the only pen realising over £90 per head.

Light lambs very mixed in quality reflected in the trade, 33kg to 160p/kg but several pens of hill lambs 152p/kg to 155p/kg.
