Consistent numbers again, with cattle a little more mixed today. A super show of bulls coupled with some well finished clean cattle sold to a very firm trade throughout. Only cattle too lean proved difficult to place.

A useful compliment of steers saw a high of 324p/kg with over thirty months' old to £2217 in the lump.

Best heifers sold to an excellent 368p/kg with heavy females to £2080.

Some great suckler bulls saw a high of 314p/kg with heavies easy to sell to just short of £2500!

56 CLEAN CATTLE

12 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 287P/KG

A super red Limmie from Marcus Whiteman stole the honours here at 600kg and 324p/kg. Mrs B sold her 640kg Simmental to 310p/kg in second spot, with Max Ossig's 32 month Blue steer 734kg to 302p/kg (£2216.68).

44 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 305P/KG

A super run from Neale Dalton excelled at 368p/kg for 510kg Limousin heifer, with another to 355p/kg from the same home. Three Limousins from Roger Jordin all made 358p/kg around the 550kg mark or £1983 in the lump. Harvey Parkes best sold to 356p/kg for 526kg. The Dalton stable was in the money again with their 646kg Limousin adding up at £2080.23 (322p/kg).

An average very similar to last week averaging 293p/kg. Blue Tongue seems now to be affecting the normal trading pattern, with the restricted area getting ever closer. Lambs from inside the restricted zone can travel to approved abattoirs but upon arrival must be processed within 2 hours so it has never been as important to present sheep clean and dry. It is highly likely that within the next four weeks or so Shropshire will be within the zone.

Lambs this week sold to 338p/kg for 43.5kg from George Evans, Day House whose exceptional run of Texel x lambs average 45kg and 320p/kg. Dry, meated lambs short in supply.

Heavier lambs 60kg to 296p/kg £179 from Ben Johnson and £175 from Richard Styles with plenty of interest in lambs over 48kg.

Lambs under 40kg not the best, with Rita's 39kg black lambs to 296p/kg, otherwise lambs generally traded 280p/kg plus.
