140 PRIME CATTLE

Improved numbers of clean cattle with the quality of our entry very good indeed. Trade was similar to last week's hardening of prices with perhaps the very best heifers better value for butchers. The continued stagnation of dead-weight prices is the result of producers' blinkered marketing strategy as they keep abattoirs satisfied with numbers of cattle. Our advice is to keep supply tight and take advantage of the increased returns in the live ring.

More steers forward saw a very nice trade selling to 225p/kg with heavies to £1500.

Butchers heifers sold to 240p/kg on three occasions with heavier sorts to just short of £1400.

More bulls are needed at the moment with the black and white trade a revelation. Continentals to 209p/kg with few best sucklers forward. Herefords sold to 200p/kg with Holsteins to 179p/kg and a very few below 150p/kg whatever they were! It will be interesting to see whether the increased corn prices hinder the supply of bulls to the trade.

4 COWS sold to a similar trade with Limousin cross Farm Assured to 109p/kg for 672kg with meat Holstein steakers to 104p/kg.

94 CLEAN CATTLE

22 steers sold to average 191p/kg – British Blues and Limousins to 225p/kg for a "very deserving cause" with others to 219p/kg. 598kg Limousins from Dave Chilton sold to 217p/kg, with 694kg to 216p/kg from Mark Pinnock. Handy-weight 526kg from Mr Randles to 209p/kg. Heavy-weights to £1499.04 from Mark Pinnock.

72 heifers sold to av. 208p/kg – Three vendors are mentioned in dispatches with Roger Jordin, Frank Millichamp and Richard Parkes all achieving 240p/kg for their Continentals around 500kg. Heavier females sold to £1385.28 from the Jordin Bros and to similar for Blondes from the Millichamps

46 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 173P/KG

More bulls were needed, as previously stated, with Brian Watkins selling handy-weight Blondes to 209p/kg for 514kg, with 600kg Hereford crosses from Graham Johnson to 200p/kg. 642kg Limousins from John Hewitt sold to 199p/kg, with 600kg Limousin crosses to 198p/kg from Colin Evans.

Holsteins from Todd Harris sold to 179p/kg, with Lee Preece selling to 174p/kg and Ed Bunning to 173p/kg.
