167 PRIME CATTLE

Even though there is no real bite, the trade was a little better today. Less handy-weight cattle forward but with heavier more commercial heifers selling a little dearer. Our market average would not necessarily reflect this improvement, with more heavy, over-fat and/or over-age cattle penned.

On a very much more important note – the market managed to pass its ABM market assurance inspection today – the boxes have all been ticked and they have gone away leaving a small "to do list". Fantastic news you must agree.

Anyway, less of the sarcasm! Less quality steers forward which sold to a high of 196p/kg with heavies to £1355.

As previously stated, small shop heifers were in short supply and sold to 249p/kg, with heavier females to £1316. More quality heifers could have sold today especially 520kg or below. Bull trade a touch better also with a very mixed bag forward. Handy-weight suckler bulls sold to 210p/kg, with heavies to £1336. Meated and black and white bulls sold to 177p/kg or £1017 in the lump.

14 COWS SOLD TO AV. 99P/KG

Cows were easiest sold once again but with no best cows forward. British Blue cross cows sold to 115p/kg for 678kg, with Saler crosses 682kg to the same. 746kg non-assured Holsteins to 104p/kg.

Only 17 steers sold to av. 160p/kg – Gordon Jones topped this section with his 586kg Limousin at 196p/kg, with Charolais crosses to 185p/kg from Phillip Terry. 770kg Blonde crosses lotted up to £1355 from Frank Millichamp, Friesian steers to £949 from the Truswells.

99 heifers sold to av. 187p/kg — Top honours went to Roger Jordin who sold his 508kg Limmie to 249p/kg, with 464kg Lims to 246p/kg from Ray & Marianne Bason. 470kg Lims sold to 244p/kg from Richard Parkes. The Jordins sold heavier females to £1316, with another to £1302 from Neale Dalton.

51 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 164P/KG

Handy-weight 540kg and 554kg Limousins from IGC Morris both hit 210p/kg. 610kg Blonde crosses from Bill Yeomans sold to 194p/kg. 536kg Blue crosses sold to 191p/kg from M Preece & Co.


Black and whites were a good price selling to 177p/kg from Phil Roberts for 524kg, with James Woolrich selling heavy Friesians to £1017.60

The overall average broke the £2/kg barrier averaging 204p/kg, with trade extremely brisk from start to finish.

Super Texels from J Radcliff set the pace with the first pen selling to 218p/kg and the next topping the sale at 223p/kg for 43kg. Clean, dry hoggs realising a premium, with several runs of indoor fed sheep ringing the bell.

Heavier weights to 211p/kg for 46.5kg from Rob Breakwell. 48.5kg to 209p/kg and hoggs over 50kg to just shy of £2/kg, with 53kg to 197p/kg from Ben Rochelle and 55.5kg to 194p/kg. Remarkably, two tooth hoggs sold to £109.60 from Brian Pugh 68.5kg at 160p/kg.

Several pens of light weight hoggs to 189p/kg for 29.5kg lean Texel x hoggs and generally 24kg to 32kg traded around 180p/kg.
