A few more steers forward with numbers boosted by several Holsteins. Continentals sold to 224p/kg or £1658 in the lump.

Butchers heifers were simply off the clock selling to 298p/kg, with very few females with shape around the 500kg mark available. A great trade on more commercial breakers especially if well finished. Heavy females to £1553.

The bull trade was equal to the clean with a strong Holstein influence depleting averages. Limousin crosses sold to 230p/kg, with heavier bulls to £1536 in the lump. Black and white trade was lively selling to 205p/kg. More customers for all types of bulls today!


