#### **169 PRIME CATTLE**

A very mixed show of cattle with plenty of lean and/or ultra-fat sorts amongst some quality types. Well-finished cattle with some element of shape sold well without being any dearer than last week. More commercial cattle were in demand unless they were too small to break up or totally shapeless and without meat.

The steer entry had some decent bullocks today selling to a high of 221p/kg or £1345 in the lump.

Butchers heifers were exceptional in quality in places and sold to 243p/kg.

Bull trade was firm with well-finished bulls in strong demand whether they were sucklers or Holsteins. Handy-weight sucklers sold to 223p/kg with black and whites to 174p/kg.

ONLY 6 COWS FORWARD with half of these non-assured. Assured Limousins sold to 150p/kg for 706kg, with Friesians to 136p/kg for 694kg also FABBL registered. Fat Herefords (non-assured) sold to 94p/kg.

#### **115 CLEAN CATTLE**

31 steers sold to average 192p/kg — Handy-weight Limousins from Matt & Wendy Bower took top spot here at 221p/kg with 572kg to 219p/kg from Charlie Sandells. Two others sold to 219p/kg from the Bower holding, with 628kg Limousin x Blues to 211p/kg from Nick Foster. 586kg Limousins sold to 210p/kg for a "very deserving cause", with Blues from Keith Tolley to 206p/kg. Heavies sold to £1344.56 from Mike Evans.

83 heifers sold to av. 186p/kg — Not our usual lofty average figure with some difficult goods in a place or three today! Richard Parkes' normal quality saw three sell to 240p/kg, 241p/kg and 243p/kg. Steve Perkins' red Limmie sold to 237p/kg, with Roger Jordin and John Westwood both achieving 235p/kg. 666kg British Blues sold to £1358.64 from Nigel Fieldhouse, with 606kg Limousins to £1321.08 from Roger Tomley.

#### 55 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 180P/KG

Jan Edwards stole the limelight here with her Limousins to 223p/kg and 220p/kg. Stuart Bebb sold to 216p/kg for 606kg, with Brian Watkins's Blondes to 213p/kg.


Friesians from Roger Rowson 534kg sold to 174p/kg, with 568kg black and whites to 170p/kg from Colin Evans.
