Struggling for numbers once again and it definitely was a case of quality before quantity today. Trade continues to look favourable although the store cattle still seem dear enough to face the music! Once again cattle forward were a credit to the farmer/producers, with hardly a bad one amongst them.

A nice show of steers met a firm level of demand, selling to 298p/kg or £2017 for the heavier beasts.

Butchers' heifers topped at 340p/kg with 10 out of 41 exceeding the 300p/kg barrier. Heavy wholesale heifers sold to £2039.

Our bull entry was quality pretty well all the way with few Black and Whites penned. Four Continentals exceeded £2000 with 292p/kg top call here. Friesians with meat and belly selling to 234p/kg.

Only one traditional Hereford cow which exceeded expectations at 171p/kg for 810kg (£1385).

A great run of Simmental x Limousins from John Cantrill sold nicely to 298p/kg for 590kg with others to 288p/kg for 596kg and 592kg. 632kg Charolais crosses from 'Mrs B' sold to 287p/kg. Heavier 770kg black Limmies from Chris Jones added up nicely to £2017.40.

41 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 283P/KG

The Parkes family showed their magnificent seven to a high of 340p/kg with others to 330p/kg, 328p/kg and 323p/kg. Limmie/Blondes from Dan Watkins took silver medal at 339p/kg for 508kg. Heavier breaking females sold to £2038.72 for Dave and John Preece's 736kg Limmie, with a 614kg Limmie to £1915.68 from 'Mrs B'. Well finished cattle easiest to sell – you can't get your cattle too fit at the moment.

ONLY 22 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 266P/KG

Some cracking suckler bulls forward saw Glyn Powell following up winning the Mayfair on Friday with his 748kg and 756kg Blondes to 292p/kg and 288p/kg (£2184 and £2177). Closely following was John Hewitt's Limousins at 286p/kg and 282p/kg for 712kg and 756kg. Great Herefords from Richard Yates excelled at 272p/kg for 634kg. 658kg Friesians sold to 234p/kg from Dave Preece.

FARMING EQUIPMENT & TECHNOLOGY FUND GRANTS IN 2023

Grants for farmers, horticulturalists, forestry owners and contractors for specific items of equipment.

ANIMAL HEALTH AND WELFARE – * NOW OPEN UNTIL MIDDAY ON THURSDAY 15th JUNE*

The **Animal Health and Welfare** theme, which is now open, includes items such as:- mobile or fixed cattle handling systems, cattle crushes, head scoops, mobile or fixed sheep handling systems, weigh bars, electric fencing and ventilation fans.



The grants are for a minimum of £1,000 and maximum of £25,000 per theme, and are based on set grant amounts for each item. The grant element is usually around 40% of the item's cost, however if the price of the item you purchase results in the grant payment making up a lesser or greater percentage, this will not affect the amount of grant paid, so long as the requirements below are still met.

These requirements include all equipment which is purchased to meet the minimum specifications set out within the option guidance, to be brand new (ex-demo or second hand is not allowed) and purchased through a supplier or manufacturer. All items must also be paid for in full (part exchange is not allowed) and no items must be purchased before a grant funding agreement is offered, although it is possible to secure items with a refundable deposit if you are concerned about supply issues.

The application process is competitive with each item given a score, and applications with the highest average scores then being offered agreements.
