Trade firmer today coupled with a better show of beasts. All clean cattle sold to average 187p/kg, with heifers averaging 200p/kg all through. More cattle realising over 230p/kg than recent sales with all commodities seeing an upturn in values unless better suited to the store ring.

A small steer entry with no very best quality forward sold to a high of 206p/kg. Heavy bullocks sold to £1339.

Some very good quality heifers forward sold easily to a top price of 241p/kg, with females over 36 months to £1261.40. Smaller numbers of bulls saw a similar trade but with plenty of bidders for these. Suckler bulls were more plentiful and sold to 210p/kg with more past 200p/kg than last week. Friesians sold to 172p/kg.

17 COWS SOLD TO 115P/KG

Cow trade appears to be firming also, with best meat black Limousin crosses to 144p/kg for 646kg. 778kg Blondes sold to 132p/kg. Friesian slips sold to 126p/kg for 618kg. More cows and stock bulls were required for regular orders.

98 CLEAN CATTLE

21 steers sold to av. 182p/kg — A useful run from John Johnston sold to 206p/kg for 602kg Charolais with other Continentals in his run to 198p/kg. 618kg Blondes hit 198p/kg from Richard Milner, with 648kg Saler crosses to 196p/kg from Mike Evans.

77 heifers sold to av. 200p/kg — Richard Parkes was top draw again with his 496kg Limmie at 241p/kg, with others in his run above 230p/kg. 562kg Blondes took second spot at 239p/kg, with Steve Perkins selling to 235p/kg. James Woolrich sold two shapey Lims to 233p/kg and 232p/kg respectively, with Tom Barker and Dan Williams selling to 230p/kg. 41 month Blonde heifers sold to £1261.40 from Andrew Hudson.


59 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 175P/KG
