144 PRIME CATTLE

Similar numbers forward saw trade holding up very well on the best butchers cattle with steers a little easier by 1-2p/kg. The dry weather continues to encourage cattle to abattoir with plenty of cow beef coming forward. Dairy farmers in the south-west are marketing cows heavily at the moment as silage cuts are coming to nothing.

A small sample of steers penned selling to 209p/kg and £1442 in the lump. Best butchers cattle a little dearer generally with 260p/kg top call, with others in the 250p/kg and 240p/kg. Butchers cattle to £1339 in the lump.

More bulls forward with good runs of well meated Holsteins forward. Trade was firm with heavy Continental to 214p/kg, with Saler bulls to £1414. Holsteins sold to 169p/kg with plenty of weight up with black and whites around the £1200 mark.

9 COWS TO OV.AV 116P/KG

A nice show of cows met a decent trade selling to 140p/kg for 640kg Limousin crosses. Meated Holsteins sold to 117p/kg for 802kg. Cow trade looks to be at the top of the tree at the moment.

87 CLEAN CATTLE

11 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 186P/KG

Shapey Limousin crosses from the Jordin brothers sold to 209p/kg at 690kg, with 622kg Limousins to 206p/kg from James Griffin. Blondes to 200p/kg from Frank Millichamp.

76 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 209P/KG

Perhaps not quite the show of last week but still some tremendous cattle penned here. A super run from Richard Parkes sold to 260p/kg with others to 259p/kg and 249p/kg from the same home. Roger Jordin sold smart Limmies to 254p/kg + 253p/kg. Evans Curdale sold their black Limmies to 249p/kg, with David Jones selling homebred cattle to 248p/kg. Blondes also achieved 248p/kg from Brian and Dan Watkins.

57 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV 177P/KG

The Powell family took the honours here at 214p/kg for 638kg, with great shapes from Nigel Fieldhouse to 213p/kg and 210p/kg. Blondes to 258p/kg for 560kg from the Watkins clan, with two homebred Limmies to 207p/kg from David Jones. 790kg Saler to £1414 from Rob Thomas.

A great show of meaty Holsteins sold to 169p/kg from Bob Mayer for 688kg with 744kg to £1205.28 from this stable. All black and whites in strong demand.
