With number nearing normality, a fantastic trade resulted with some well-fleshed cattle forward generally, with the larger dead-weight players taking approximately 5p/kg out of their quoted figures this Monday; our trade did not reflect this as the live auction drives forward trade and does not follow it!

A great result in the clean cattle section saw steers selling to 216p/kg, with no absolute stars forward and to £1347 in the lump.

Some super heifers forward sailed to 255p/kg, with others to 251p/kg with ten others 240p/kg or more. Heavy females to £1357.

Bull trade was sharp with more heavy Continentals forward. More 550kg-620kg Continentals were needed for regular orders. Top price was 222p/kg with four Limousins passed £1600 to £1641. Black and whites saw strong demand as usual selling to 175p/kg and to £1145 in the lump.

ONLY 4 COWS FORWARD all being plain cows sold accordingly with 648kg Montbeliarde cows to 76p/kg.
