PRIME CATTLE (RED)

159 PRIME CATTLE

A busier day saw demand for best cattle to meet Christmas order very good but with second quality sorts more difficult to sell- especially if too small and/or too fat. All clean cattle sold to average 193p/kg with a stronger Holstein influence in the bulls reducing the overall figure to 180p/kg.

Steer numbers were depleted and sold to 247p/kg or £1379 in the lump. A nice sample of butchers heifers saw the best selling to 251p/kg or £1455.

The bull department was painted black and white this morning with two or three suckler bulls penned which sold to 207p/kg for 562kg. Friesian Holsteins sold to 174p/kg.

ONLY 2 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Too few cattle for the buyers to get started saw Hereford x cows with meat to 120p/kg and 105p/kg. Blonde stock bulls sold to 113p/kg for 1030kg.

MORE COWS NEEDED

Those local producers selling cows in centres further afield; are you really winning? You will have a higher haulage bill, be paying more commission and your cattle will lose more weight – is the grass any greener?

105 CLEAN CATTLE

13 steers sold to av. 171p/kg – A superb 558kg Limousin from Steve Perkins soared to 247p/kg with a handy 496kg Limousin to 210p/kg. 718kg Friesians to 170p/kg from John Rogers.

92 Heifers sold to average 197p/kg – 532kg Limousins added up well at 251p/kg. Two Limousins from Jean Kirkham sold to 248p/kg and 245p/kg, with 490kg Lim to 247p/kg from Roger Jordin. Steve Perkins and Richard Parkes also achieved 240p/kg plus. John Elgin's super run of heavier sorts sold to £1455.20.

54 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 157P/KG

562kg Limousins from Rita Corfield topped this section at 207p/kg, with 626kg Lims to 195p/kg from Vincent Evans.

Frank Povall's square Friesian sold to 174p/kg for 524kg, with Mick Johnstone's black and white to 168p/kg.
