Another useful entry but a more mixed bag generally. Trade is showing signs of the January Iull as anticipated, but with generally plenty of competition for all types and qualities. Best quality cattle, especially heifers, saw trade nearly on par with last week, with more commercial beasts finding customers more discerning. There were many lorries backed up to get cattle away- always a good sign.

Steers a slightly easier trade with the best to 219p/kg for 596kg Blondes with heavies to £1332.

Butchers heifers sold to 246p/kg with several other lots passed 240p/kg. Heavy heifers with shape a good trade to £1356 in the lump

Bull trade easier also but not by much with Continentals selling to 221p/kg and Friesians to 182p/kg. More buying power for bulls so please continue to send - 60 plus bulls needed each week

15 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL This trade continues to defy gravity with pure Limousin cows 844kg to 147p/kg. Young Friesian cows sold to 129p/kg and 126p/kg, with Holstein bulls to 118p/kg.

111 CLEAN CATTLE

30 steers sold to average 180p/kg — A cracking Blonde from the Millichamp Bros sold to 219p/kg for 596kg, with 542kg Limousins to 216p/kg from John Cantrill. Three Continentals sold to 210p/kg from a "very deserving cause" with Gordon Jones also selling to 210p/kg for 594kg. Phil Clarke's Limousin sold to £1332.16 for 724kg. Holstein steers to £1198.94 from Neville Taylor.

81 heifers sold to av. 198p/kg — The usual quality from Richard Parkes topped the day at 246p/kg for 488kg British Blue, with others to 241p/kg and 240p/kg. Roger Jordin also sold to 240p/kg for 512kg Limousin. 510kg Limmies closely followed from IGC Morris at 239p/kg. 572kg British Blues added up well for Richard Morgan selling to £1355.64 with Charolais to £1317.44 from David Preece.


54 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 169P/KG

The New Year has not got off to the best of starts as the sheep trade flounders and abattoirs reduce their throughput of heavier hoggs of which there are plenty and the hardest to place.

The pattern continues with hoggs under 43kg most sought after and 30kg hoggs dearer per kilo than 50kg Continentals. Best sheep remain over 200p/kg although they are few and far between to a top price of 219p/kg for 41kg Texels from Andrew Meredith realising £89.75 and a top price per head also from Andrew Meredith of £93.50

Heavy hoggs over 50kg realised around £75 to £82, with 59kg from Sue Evans at £82.60, 44kg to 46kg hoggs at best 160p/kg. Hoggs 30kg to 37kg an improved trade with very ordinary sheep at 175p/kg to 189p/kg for 31kg. Hill breeds to 162p/kg with Welsh tup hoggs 150p/kg to 159p/kg.
