A handful fewer cattle forward saw a very firm trade once again, with commercial cattle very dear as long as they were well-fleshed. Best butcher's cattle no dearer but still above that magic 300p/kg figure on several occasions. Bull numbers were very disappointing despite the firey trade last week and sold possibly as well today with Holstein Frisians more money. Despite deadweight outlets putting up prices, the live ring continues to add value in almost every case.

A smaller compliment of steers sold to 304p/kg to a top price of £1924 in the lump.

Heifers topped at 318p/kg with eleven 300p/kg or above. Heavy females added up to a high of £1951.20.

Too few bulls to get some orders started sold to a top of 246p/kg for continentals, with Black and Whites selling to 224p/kg.
