### PRIME CATTLE (RED)

#### 114 PRIME CATTLE

We had a useful trade last week but then the beef has proved more difficult to sell since then and trade was harder work today. Saying that, abattoirs dropped their quotations for Monday morning 2-3p/kg again this week and our cattle are well in line with these prices and better than Monday centres. All clean cattle sold to average 193p/kg.

There were some tidy steers forward but many on the lean side. British Blues sold to 220p/kg on two occasions, with heavies falling just short of £1350.

Butchers heifers held up well considering, selling to a high of 243p/kg or £1332 in the lump.

There are several 30-48 month clean cattle included on our averages.

With bull numbers tight everywhere, buyers are struggling to fill loads. Only 27 forward today, with best sucklers to 220p/kg or £1550 in the lump. Friesian Holsteins met plenty of competition to 179p/kg.

#### 24 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO AV. 104P/KG

A very good trade but without quite the edge of last week. However, our best cows would be dearer than the preferred Monday evening centres.

736kg Limousin cows sold to 151p/kg from Gordon Jones (£1111.36). British Blue crosses from Bob Beaman and Frank Millichamp both sold over £1000. Traditional red Herefords sold to 126p/kg for Geoff Parton. Limousin stock bulls 808kg sold to 124p/kg from Stuart Bebb.

#### 87 CLEAN CATTLE

**28 steers sold to av. 187p/kg** – Three British Blues from LH Wardle took the honours here with two at 220p/kg and the third at 215p/kg. Alastair Beedles also sold 626kg Limousins to 215p/kg, with his 698kg Limmie adding up to £1347.14. Simmental cross steers to £1340 from Brian & Dave Whiteman.

**59 Heifers sold to average 195p/kg** – A superb black Limousin cross from Steve Perkins took the honours at 243p/kg for 544kg. Richard Parkes sold three crackers above 230p/kg to a high of 235p/kg, with Dave Chilton achieving the same for his handier weight. Heavies sold to £1331.52 from Ian Morris.

Too few bulls to satisfy orders today saw best Limousin suckler bulls to 220p/kg for 660kg from Matthew & Wendy Bower. 546kg Blondes sold to 207p/kg from Brian Watkins

with 644kg Blondes to 206p/kg from Matt Parkes. Friesians sold to 179p/kg from Mary Beaumont. Heavy Limmies to £1550.52 again from the Bower stable.
