146 PRIME CATTLE

Fewer clean cattle forward saw trade dearer than Monday reports but with a lacklustre feel with cattle selling for values below cost of production. A larger bull compliment helps fulfil orders with the lesser types looking well sold against the best. The overall market average of 165p/kg included several cattle best suited and also more valuable through a store ring.

Very few bullocks forward saw the best meated types selling to 201p/kg or £1252.96. There were several steers too lean or over 36 months. A sharpish trade on butchers heifers saw handy weights to 241p/kg for 490kg. Three others sold over 230p/kg.

A busy bull section with 78 forward. Continental bulls with meat attracted some interest with very lean bulls difficult. Friesian/Holsteins, although below vendor expectations, saw trade 10-20p/kg dearer than Monday markets.

18 COWS SOLD TO AV. 107P/KG

Again more demand on cows than most other beef varieties. Fed Limousins topped at 155p/kg for 736kg with two others over 140p/kg. Hereford x Friesians to 126p/kg with flesh. Meat Holsteins sold to 105p/kg with bag and belly. Jersey crosses to 105p/kg.

68 CLEAN CATTLE

11 steers sold to average 160p/kg. A difficult trade if you had not got the goods. Simmentals from Charlie Sandells sold to 190p/kg to 201p/kg for 562kg and 548kg. British Blue crosses sold to 191p/kg from Phil Roberts. 628kg Limousins to 175p/kg from John Jebb. 38m Herefords to 134p/kg from John Pritchard.

57 heifers sold to average 188p/kg. A super run from Stuart Bebb sold to 241p/kg for 490kg Limousin with others to 230p/kg and 228p/kg. Heavier sorts but very shapey Blondes from Roger Jordin sold to 230p/kg x 2, with his 650kg Lim x Blue to 226p/kg (£1469). There were plenty of others above 200p/kg.

78 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 152P/KG

There were 35 Holsteins/Friesians, Brown Swiss etc forward. Shapey Blondes from Dan & Brian Watkins topped the day at 191p/kg and 194p/kg for 582kg and 524kg. 678kg Limousins sold to 192p/kg from Matt Bower with 624kg British Blues to 191p/kg from Ed Green.

Friesians sold to 163p/kg to 160p/kg from Dave Thomas with Henry Yates selling to 159p/kg.

The lamb trade back on last week but well in line with national and local averages. In fact, apart from a few headline prices Bridgnorth's trade would compare very favourably with anywhere.

Dave Ball's Texels topped the sale at 278p/kg for 38.5kg but the main highlight of the day would be the general trade on commercial lambs with weight in demand to 266p/kg for 40kg and to £110 per head and 42kg at 262p/kg.

Light weights a better trade than expected with 30kg to 37kg lambs proving a very brisk trade with 34.5kg to 260p/kg and generally 245p/kg plus.
