173 PRIME CATTLE

A good complement of cattle forward found trade a little easier than last week's flier, although farmers with best quality would hardly notice the difference as these held values more easily. Over-fat or very plain cattle were more difficult to place but this has been the case for some time but has become more pronounced.

Fewer steers forward with more heavier, leaner types penned. Best suckler bullocks sold to 212p/kg or £1320 in the lump. With the supermarket processors discounting heavier carcasses, these larger sorts are becoming harder to place.

Butchers heifers met a super trade with the best sorts as dear as recent sales to 250p/kg. Heavier heifers a little easier, with more commercial types harder work.

A very mixed sample of bulls saw trade a little easier also but there were very few best young barley bulls forward. 626kg Limousins over 16 months sold to 200p/kg. Holstein bulls sold to 166p/kg with no very best black and whites forward. Nonassured, heavy, very lean bulls difficult to place.

12 COWS SOLD TO AV. 91.04P/KG

A disappointing number of cows forward with four buyers stood around the ring. A fair trade but with no best cows to boost averages. Friesian cows with meat sold to 114p/kg from Henry Yates, with two others to 104p/kg. Boning cows down to 60p/kg for 468kg.

MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS URGENTLY NEEDED

106 CLEAN CATTLE

19 steers sold to av. 178p/kg – Shapey Limousin steers from John Gore took the honours at 212p/kg closely followed by Steven Woods' Limmie at 209p/kg. 612kg Limousins from the Kincaid stable sold to 208p/kg. Handier weight butchers steers to 191p/kg from Julian Aston. Holstein bullocks to 155p/kg from Mike Barnett.

67 heifers sold to av. 201p/kg – A superb run of seven from Richard Parkes sold to 252p/kg to average 248p/kg – about halfpenny less than last Tuesday! 472kg Limmies from Peter Raybould sold to 250p/kg, with his 612kg model to 238p/kg or £1456.56 in the lump. Second quality sorts harder work especially if fat or lacking meat.
