Following last week's bonanza, trade did feel slightly 'after the Lord Mayor's Show' today. Realistically this was always going to be the case, with buyers' 'licking their wounds' from last Tuesday. More of a mixed bag of cattle entered this morning with more grass cattle and dairy bred sorts in front of the auctioneer, but still good averages to report with all clean cattle averaging 212p/kg and bulls nearly 190p/kg.

More steers forward sold well and especially the quality end to 240p/kg or £1572 in the lump. Fresh buyers for second quality breaking cattle today but they needed to be farm assured and under 30 months.

All heifers averaged 221p/kg as compared with 242p/kg last week. An easier trade yes, but some more commercial and heavier sorts forward also contributed to this lower figure. Best butcher's cattle still sold to 273p/kg but more heifers in the 230p/kg – 260p/kg than the 260p/kg – 290p/kg bracket! Heavy heifers sold well if meated to £1425 in the lump.

A great result on the bull section with more required to satisfy orders. Best Continentals sold to 234p/kg with heavy bulls to £1528. Black & Whites sold to a strong level of demand to 189p/kg.

3 cows forward sold to a level trade with Fleckvieh crosses topping at 117p/kg for 804kg, with several abattoirs dropping cow prices fairly dramatically on Monday morning this week.

A great run of home-bred Charolais crosses from Edward Howells sold to £1425.24 for 642kg.

A firm trade throughout headed by a shapey Limmie from John Griffiths at 234p/kg for 580kg. 558kg Lims from Charlie Sandells sold to 226p/kg, with 686kg Salers from Howard Mold selling to 218p/kg. 602kg Simmentals on the quick side from Dave & Archie Meddins sold to 215p/kg.

Heavy Salers to £1528.32 for 768kg from the Mold stable once again!

Handier weight lambs would be the most sought after, with the more commercial types well sold around 210p/kg. Light weights under 35kg to 211p/kg from Martin Pain with Welsh tup lambs selling as well as anything 195p/kg to 200p/kg.




