193 PRIME CATTLE

More cattle forward with once again some quality sorts amongst the entry. Trade was very sharp with some Christmas holiday trade still evident. Handy weight butchers cattle were especially sought after helping our overall average (including plenty of Holstein bulls) to a very respectable 203p/kg.

Steer quality was not the very best today and included several over thirty month cattle. Best Limousins sold to 231p/kg or £1491.60 in the lump. A super show of butchers heifers sold to 267p/kg, with heavy females to £1529.08. Commercial sorts met strong of competition.

Mostly Holsteins forward this morning – best suckler bulls sold to 225p/kg. Well finished bulls saw a firmer trade, with Holsteins with meat selling to 191p/kg or £1192.80 per head.

ONLY 10 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

A small sample forward today with some producers holding on to cows to get them fit for the New Year and hopefully a better trade?

738kg British Blue cross cows sold to 110p/kg for Matthew Bower, with 702kg Holsteins to 104p/kg from Simon Brown. Ultra-lean Hereford stock bulls 81p/kg for 834kg.

142 CLEAN CATTLE

25 steers sold to an overall average 190p/kg. 614kg and 607kg Limousins from Gordon Jones sold to 231p/kg and 227p/kg respectively. Blondes from Frank Millichamp sold to 229p/kg at 30 months. 560kg Limousins from Alastair Beedles achieved 215p/kg. Holsteins to 173p/kg from Dave Cantrill. Montbeliarde steers to 195p/kg for 35 months for Martin Poynton.

117 heifers sold to an overall average of 212p/kg. Handyweight Continentals sold to 267p/kg, with others from 251p/kg to 261p/kg all from IGC Morris. 506kg Limousins sold to 263p/kg from Roger Jordin, with 496kg Lims from Richard Parkes to 261p/kg. Robert Morris' super run of five topped at 258p/kg for 492kg. Numerous others sold above 250p/kg. 602kg British Blues sold to £1529.08 again from the Jordin stable, with John Elgin selling to £1518.44 for 638kg Limousin.

Bull trade was a little sharper with a large show of Holsteins etc. Forest Vale Growers sold Blondes to 225p/kg for 552kg at 13 months. Handy 466kg Charolais sold to 216p/kg from Peter Jones. 636kg British Blue crosses sold to 207p/kg from Mike Evans, with 678kg Blondes to 204p/kg from Howard Mold who also sold to £1410 for 750kg 20 months old.

Friesians from John White sold to 193p/kg (£1192.80). Montbeliardes sold to 205p/kg from Charlie Lloyd. Julian Aston sold to 176p/kg with his Holstein bulls.
