A busier cattle section saw trade a little easier following the Christmas Primestock Show last week. There were some very good cattle forward coupled with some that should have waited until January or alternatively needed selling in the last month! Obviously a clear out for Christmas! Best fleshed sorts held their values more easily with second string cattle finding customers as long as the price was right.

The Steer entry was mixed in weight and shape with Continentals selling to 215p/kg or £1308 in the lump.

Some tidy butchers heifers forward but with many heavy enough for most tastes, or sometimes on the leanside to keep the weight down to get the best pence per kilo.247p/kg was achieved on two occasions, with heavy females to £1270.

Not too many bulls penned this morning with bull trade generally holding its own. Continentals sold to 195p/kg, with heavy Continentals to £1493 in the lump. Black and Whites sold to 164p/kg with belly being penalised.

14 COWS SOLD TO OV.AV. 88P/KG

More cows in the Christmas tidy up, met a equivalent trade to recently Blue cows sold to 124p/kg for 736kg (£912.64) with 684kg Limousin crosses to 113p/kg.

122 CLEAN CATTLE

ONLY 20 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 168P/KG

A nice run of homebred Limousins from Alastair Beedles sold to 215p/kg with others to 209p/kg. John Cantrill's meaty Limmie sold to 207p/kg. Second quality Steers and overages less money in line with reduced deadweight quotes for the week.

102 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 184P/KG

Richard Parkes' usual sample of butchers weight Continentals sold to 247p/kg on two occasions, with another to 245p/kg. Greg Thomas' half ton Limousin flew in at 241p/kg with Roger Jordin selling to 240p/kg and 238p/kg (£1270.92)

38 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 162P/KG

Roger Tomley was top dog here today at 195p/kg for his Limousin at 678kg, with Richard and Ben Prince selling to 191p/kg for 716kg. Their 798kg Limousins sold nicely to £1492.26 in the lump. Roger Rowson's meaty Friesians sold to 164p/kg at 566kg with Colin Evans selling to 163p/kg for 580kg, with the Black and White trade continuing on an even keel!

With a number of very good shaped lambs well over 220 to 239p/kg for 43.5kg Beltex Lambs from R Hopkins. Generally, 38kg to 42kg lambs only over £2 if Continental, Clean and Finished.

It is becoming more important to market lambs in a clean, dry state with several customers looking to process lambs early on Tuesdays.

Heavier lambs to £106 – 50kg Texels from Andrew Meredith. 212p/kg and 47kg Texels from Lee Preece to 220p/kg. Commercial 50kg plus lambs to 184p/kg from Roger Swift. Plenty £90 to £95 per head.
