Numbers tight with trade holding up well on anything with meat. Prices look set to remain firm into the New Year as abattoirs are very much hand-to-mouth with supply of suitable cattle.

A small steer entry, with mainly good sorts forward, saw a high of 352p/kg or £2224 in the lump with seven out of eight over £2000.

Heifers were tremendous quality and sold to 362p/kg on two occasions with the heaviest of these adding up to £2223.
